WHAT DO WE BRING?

You need to pack your regular camp articles listed on the camp brochure or website plus shorts, two pairs of sneakers (soccer shoes, if you have them), also bring a **white** tee shirt and a **blue** tee shirt for Thursday and Friday evening's "International Matches", and a lot of enthusiasm! Tuesday will be Soccer Club day and we ask you to please bring your favorite professional **Soccer Club** Jersey, on Thursday we will focus on International Team day and we ask that you please bring your favorite **International team** jersey for our camp group photo as well as your own soccer club jersey.

For your protection you **must** have a pair of shin guards. You may also want to have your own mouthpiece and toe nail clippers.
